

SUM - THE "BEING" VERB

sum means **I am.** sumus means **We are.**
 es means **You (singular) are.** estis means **You (plural) are.**
 est means **He (she, it) is, there is.** sunt means **They are, there are.**

Use the forms of sum to "link" a subject (*nominative*) with another word in the nominative case that renames the subject (*predicate nominative*).

sunt	they are
Sum puer.	You are the boy.
Es puer.	I am the boy.
